- 43 thousand new individual annuity policies were sold with a total policy amount of ¥154.9 billion.





- The total number of policies in force for individual insurance policies and the insurance policies of Postal Life Insurance was 34.53 million.




- Annualized premiums from new policies consisted of ¥117.0 billion for individual insurance policies and ¥53.5 billion for individual annuity policies.







- Note 3 The ¥4.9 billion increase in total shareholders' equity was attributable to ¥3.5 billion of reversal of beginning balance following the amendment to the Accounting Standard for Retirement Benefits, ¥16.8 billion of dividend payment to shareholders and the recording of net income of ¥25.3 billion.
