2 Goals

(1) Increase the number of employees taking childcare leave to the following levels*

Male employees... 100%

Female employees ... 100%

*Rate of employees taking childcare leave: Percentage of employees who have given birth (or whose spouse has given birth) during the period covered by the plan and who have begun to take childcare leave (including those who plan to begin taking leave)

*Excluding individuals not wishing to take childcare leave.

(2) Increase the percentage of female managers at the head office to 30% or more by April 1, 2031.

3 Initiatives and Implementation Schedule

Initiative 1: Pursue work-style reform and encourage work-life balance (initiatives to reduce total working hours and overtime)

- · May 2021 Reduce long working hours

Initiative 2: Strive to create a workplace culture in which both men and women play active roles while achieving work-life balance

- May 2021 Distribute information that contributes to work-life balance via the Work-Life Balance information website
